Assistant Professor of Landscape Architecture

The Landscape Architecture Program in the Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry, and Consumer Sciences at West Virginia University is pleased to invite applications for a 9-month tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor to commence on January 1, 2005 or August 16, 2005.

Duties and Responsibilities

The successful candidate will teach a range of courses in one or more of the following areas: construction, technology, plant materials/ecology, design, planning, and graphics. In addition to teaching, the faculty member will advise students within the program and will pursue research/creative practice and service activities in planning and design areas relevant to the region and the state of West Virginia.

Qualifications

Candidates must hold a Master of Landscape Architecture degree or a Bachelor of Landscape Architecture degree with a terminal degree in an allied discipline. Candidates must demonstrate design and research abilities and a working knowledge of current computer applications in landscape architecture. Professional experience in design or community planning is desirable.

Program

The Landscape Architecture Faculty consists of seven full-time members. The Program enrolls approximately 160 undergraduate students in an accredited BSLA program. West Virginia University has some 24,000 students and is located in north central West Virginia in Morgantown, a small city that was recently ranked among the most livable small cities in the Northeast.
